

Early Addresses and Articles 1927 - 1938

John Anderson's first decade at Sydney University was characterised by two features: his adherence to Communism and then Trotskyism, and his extensive philosophical writings. The material cited below reflects these two features. There are a large number of writings for the Communist publications, *The Workers Weekly* and *The Communist*, and for the Trotskyist publication, *The Militant*. Similarly there are a large number of writings for the *A.J.P.P.*. Apart from these writings, there are a large number of addresses for a number of student societies, particularly the Freethought Society and the Literary Society. These were typically reported in *Honi Soit* and the *Union Recorder*.
